Using Your Card

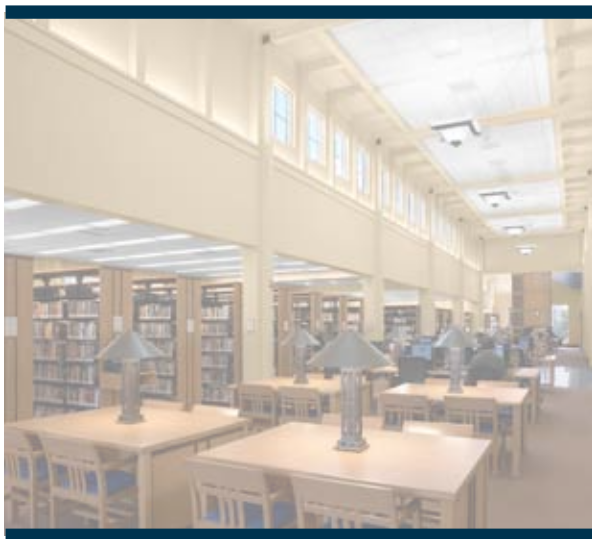
By receipt of a Chelsea District Library card you agree to comply with all Library policy, pay fines and to make good on any lost or damaged materials checked out with this card. There will be a fee to replace lost or damaged cards.

You may "load" your library card with money to pay for printing and copying services at the APM machine located on the 2nd floor. Library fines are separate and must be paid at the Circulation Desk.

If you send a friend or family member to pick up your materials they must have your library card. (That is how we know they have your permission to have your materials.)

Your PIN

When you sign up for a card you are assigned a PIN number to use when accessing the catalog or using our Internet computers. It is usually the last four digits of your phone number but you can request a different number or change the number once you have an account.

Chelsea District Library Acceptable Use of the Internet

- Computer use is limited to 60 minutes if others are waiting.
- Altering computer settings is prohibited.
- Illegal use of the Internet will result in immediate revocation of Internet privileges at the Library and notification of local authorities.

Using the Internet via SAMS

The Chelsea District Library uses a filtering system called SAMS on the Library's public computers. This technology allows parents to choose a specific level of filtering for their children while still allowing adults full, unfiltered access to the Internet.

The wireless network and data ports available to the public using their own equipment are unsecured, unencrypted and unfiltered. Users of the Library's wireless network or data ports are required to abide by Internet Access and Public Computing Use policy.

To use the Internet on the Library's public computers all users must read, understand, register and sign for an Internet access card. Minors must be registered by a parent/legal guardian who must select a level of filtering. Minors may not, under any circumstance, have unfiltered access to the Internet on the Library's public computers.

Filtering products are imperfect in many ways. Users should understand that filters are no guarantee that objectionable material will not be seen or viewed. Filters attempt to block limited amounts of material of specific content while often blocking benign sites that users seek to access.
